1	05/01/12 Callout request received at 04:16	Search Call - The Team was asked to assist Patterdale MRT, along with Kendal, Kirkby Stephen and Keswick MRTs and dog handlers from across Northern England, to look for a gentleman who had not reported in to his accommodation in Patterdale. A search was conducted of the valleys and fell tops in the Glenridding area but nothing was found.	16	10.00
2	19/02/12 Callout request received at 14:47	Rescue Call - A 55 year old gentleman fell down steep and craggy ground near Long Stile above Blea Water, High Street. The Team was asked to effect his rescue and immediately called for an RAF Sea King to assist. An Air Ambulance was tasked by NW Ambulance Service and was able to get a paramedic quickly on scene. Kirkby Stephen MRT was also asked to provide back up in the event of a stretcher carry being required. Sadly the gentleman was pronounced dead at the scene. He was winched by Sea King and handed over to a waiting ambulance at Mardale Head.	13	4.00
